 - Build strong, supportive relationships with site coordinators, volunteer coaches, and school/community partners.
 - Manage site setup and logistics, including registration, scheduling, and ongoing communications.
 - Communicate effectively with coaches, parents and site coordinators, including ongoing responses to inquiries from coaches and caregivers and through scheduled information through program season.
 - Conduct site visits to ensure program quality and provide support.
 - Oversight and coordination of all curriculum materials, including ordering and inventory of materials.

- Communicate, schedule and organize volunteer needs including in-office opportunities, community events and 5K.
